EDUCATION - Helping children and youth achieve their potential

Gift per pay period	Annual Gift (26 pay periods)	Results after one year
\$1	\$26	Trains two volunteer scout leaders.
\$5	\$130	Provides a family one hour of parent-child counseling service.
\$15	\$390	Enrolls two low-income youth in after school programs.
\$20	\$520	Gives a child one year of club activities and one week at summer camp.
\$40	\$1,040	Equals one month of full-time childcare for two pre-school aged children.

\$5	\$130	Gives three women personal assistance and professional clothing for a job.
\$15	\$390	Sends four people to a financial skills class.
\$22	\$572	Keeps four working families on the job by subsidizing child care.
\$40	\$1,040	Provides three families with emergency rental assistance.
